The trail takes approx. 45mins to complete so we would recommend visiting either the village element of the trail or Roald Dahl's grave only. Many of the village sites can be spotted on the walk from your coach drop-off point. Incorporating the trail on your walk to the Museum might be a nice way to start your day.)
- 11am 12.30pm facilitated session part 1 within the Museum
- 12.30pm Lunch
- 1pm 2pm facilitated session part 2 within the Museum
- 2pm School session finishes

Access to the Museum galleries is only possible during your facilitated school sessions. However, access to the children's eating areas and toilets will be available at all times outside of your facilitated sessions. The shop will also be open from 10am on Thursdays and Fridays.
